Purpose:

The purpose of the FFACS Scholarship is to recognize, encourage, and support graduate students who have prevailed over obstacles to personal success and academic achievement.

Scholarship Criteria:

1. Candidates must be accepted into full-time attendance at a post-secondary program (apprenticeship, college, university).
2. The candidate must be between 17 and 22 years old and demonstrate an element of financial need to receive the award.
3. Candidate must demonstrate academic, athletic, and or social excellence within the community.
4. The candidate must be a resident of the Greater Toronto Area (GTA) and be available for an interview.
5. Students selected to receive the award must attend the Scholarship Dinner function to receive the award.
6. The award scholarship shall have a value of up to \$1000.00. or more depending on the sponsor.
