Background:

The Free For All Community Services (FFACS) is a non-profit organization that provides culturally appropriate programs to youths with a focus on at-risk cases. Scholarships are awarded to students who have demonstrated academic, athletic, and social excellence within the community. FFACS organization offers quality recreational, educational, and cultural programs that promote social, intellectual, and emotional development of youths from diverse backgrounds and communities.

Purpose:

The purpose of the FFACS Scholarship is to recognize, encourage, and support graduating students who have prevailed over obstacles to personal success and academic achievement.

Scholarship Criteria:

- 1. Candidate must be accepted into fulltime attendance at a post-secondary program (apprenticeship, college, university).
- 2. Candidate must be between 17 and 21 years old and demonstrate an element of financial need to receive the award.
- 3. Candidate must demonstrate academic, athletic, and or social excellence within the community.
- 4. Candidate must be a resident of the Greater Toronto Area (GTA) and be available for an interview.
- 5. <u>Students selected to receive the award must attend the Scholarship Dinner function in order to receive the award.</u>
- 6. The award scholarship shall have a value of up to \$1000.00.

- An updated copy of your transcript (preferable after the June final exams).
- An acceptance letter (or a tuition receipt) from the institution you will be attending.

Timeline: To be submitted no later than August 15th. Scholarship will be awarded at our annual dinner in October.
